





Thenk you for choosing Norwegian Cruise Line. We are excited to welcome you aboard it

Please note, the itinerary for your upcoming crules vacation has tender parts which are subject to change without notice.

Contain vessel transfers, such as tendering and gangwaya, may not be fully accessible to wheelchairs or accetars which may result in your insbility to go ashare. When a ship is unable to dody guests are taken where an amalier boats called tenders. Some guests with limited mobility may find it difficult to embark or disembark the ship at certain times while at dock or while tendering. Plasse note, the itinerary for your apcorning crules vecation has tender ports which are subject to change without notice.

- We are unable to provide assistance from the ship to tender and/or from tender to shore for guests with accoters and/or wheelchairs that weigh a combined 100 lbs, Guesta tendering to Great Stimup Cay may be exempt from this. The Staff Captain will determine if the transfer is able to take place. Factors such as weather and use conditions are taken into consideration.
- Mobility devices must be able to fold in order to be accommodated onboard the tender.
- Guests may have to utilize steps or a staircase to access the tender and re-board the vessel.

To assure we have all your requirements, we ask that you fill out and submit the Accessibility & Medical Questionnaire, in mail The detailed information provided on the form will help us understand your specific needs. This form should be submitted as soon a possible. If we do not receive your completed form, we may not be able to provide you with the assistance you need. Once you have submitted the form, our Access Deak will respond within 30 days.








Tipping

Cruise lines, like Norwegian, include automatic tips either at time of booking or on your onboard account when disembarking for your stateroom steward. When ordering drinks at a bar or food at a specialty restaurant, gratuity will already be added to the bill.
